3.11. Elohim watedaber and 2nd morning star

From my notes on special experiences:

June 2, 2009 (Tuesday, before 3:00 a.m.)

Half in a dream, half-awake I see: אלהים ותדבר elohim watedaber; First Book of the Chronicles 17:17 (the only passage in the Bible with this phrase)

The verse reads as follows:

"And yet this was a small thing in thine eyes, O God; for thou hast also spoken of thy servant's house for a great while to come, and hast regarded me according to the estate of a man of high degree, O LORD God." (Translator's note: Bible quote in the German original from the Schlachter Bible; the English translation uses the King James Bible.)

After I'd found this verse, I got down on my knees at the window to worship God and question Him. The morning star had apparently risen not long ago. Suddenly, I saw a "second morning star" moving away from the first. After a while, a light began to blink. It may have been a helicopter, but for me it was a memorable image.
